### P.E. AND SPORT PREMIUM

#### REPORT FOR 2013/2014

- **WHAT IS IT?**

In 2013, the Government announced funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increased participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

- **HOW MUCH?**

Our school received £8000 plus £5 per child. That is a total of £9060 in the academic year September 2013/July 2014

- **WHAT DID WE SPEND IT ON? AND WHAT WAS ITS IMPACT?**

Since September 2013;

Hire of qualified coaches or specialist PE teachers to work alongside each class teacher for one hour per week	<b>£4890.91</b>	Increased teachers' subject knowledge and confidence in a wide range of physical activities including football, street dance, tennis, gymnastics (and from April 2014) athletics and multi-skills The school has established links with local sports clubs from which the coaches came
The school bought into local sports networks (Agilitas and The Deepings School) by pooling funding – a well-established system in the Deepings area Transporting of pupils to events	<b>£1715.70</b>	Increased pupil participation in competitions, tournaments and festivals with other schools Expert advice on-hand for P.E. Leader
PE equipment has been upgraded and renewed – an investment for now and for the future	<b>£1715.84</b>	Pupils have access to high-quality equipment across a wide range of sports

After-school clubs run by trained coaches and teachers offered to all pupils in Y1 to Y6. Sports on offer include; cross-country, multi-skills, Irish dancing, gymnastics, netball, football and athletics	<b>£350.00</b>	Increased access to sports. Involvement in sport and exercise beyond P.E. lesson
Staff attend training in specific areas of PE; dance, gymnastics	<b>£120.00</b>	Staff gain subject knowledge to use in delivery of lessons Expand resources available to teaching staff
Release of P.E. Leader to survey staff and pupils	<b>£128.00</b>	School leaders and governors provided with evidence of impact of Premium School leaders plan strategically for future use
