Access continuous provision. Match and sort objects, shapes and amounts. Compare amounts- more, fewer or same? Compare size, mass and capacity. Exploring pattern.


## Literacy

Handle books correctly and follow print left to right, top to bottom. Learn to blend words orally— Fred talk games. RWI: Learn to read all single letter Set 1 sounds and practise writing them daily.

Understanding the World

Past and Present: Understand order from baby to adult– basic chronology/ timeline. Talk about members of their family and community— share photos and discuss. Understand recent past through stories and photos. The Natural World: Learn how humans grow and change. Name common body parts. Seasonal Changes: exploring Autumn
