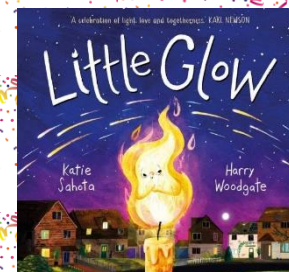


Foundation Stage Term 2
