Year 3 Term 5 Ancient Egyptians

Religious Education Why is water symbolic?

The children will discuss the importance of water, explore the relevance of it in religious stories and what it symbolises in different religions and cultures.

Computing

Create Media

The children will be using text and images within software to create published pieces of work. They will learn and use vocabulary such as template, placeholder and orientation to plan and edit their work.

DT

In DT the children will learn about food and eating seasonally. They will explore where food comes from and the importance of 'food miles' before designing and making their own healthy dish.

English

We will be writing adventure stories and playscripts. The focus will be on using the animation 'Taking Flight' as a stimulus.

The class text is 'You're a bad man, Mr Gum'.

Why were tomb raiders in Ancient Egypt?

We will be finding out who the Ancient Egyptians were, the three distinct periods in their history and how we know so much about them.

Maths

This term has a wide range of topics, including fractions, money, and time. The children will be solving problems with these to develop their mathematical reasoning.

Science

Forces and magnets, finding out what creates movement, how different surfaces impact of how freely things can move and investigating and working scientifically.

Art

Starting with a focus on a bust of Nefertiti we concentrate on shading using a grid method.

Investigate the art of Ancient Egypt, paying close attention to Tomb Models before creating some of our own.
