English

Discussion, performance and construction of playscripts, poetry, letters and information texts using The Great Kapok Tree, The Vanishing Rainforest and The Wild Robot as our inspiration.

Art

To explore multiplication and division using arrays, sharing and grouping using 2,3,4,5 and 8 times tables. We will then explore multiplication and division by a one-digit number.
