We will look at Aboriginal art and use a variety of methods to explore colour and to create our own pieces of artwork.

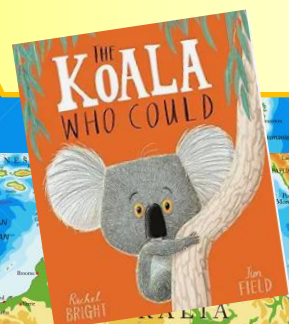
History

Computing

We will explore the world of digital art and its exciting range of creative tools. The children will use the paint programme to create their own artwork.



Geography

We will find out where Australia is in the world and learn about human and physical features. We will then compare Australia to what we have previously learnt about the United Kingdom.

We will celebrate everyone's similarities and differences and learn what bullying is and how to deal with it.

Music - In Music we will be learning about Pulse, rhythm and pitch, rapping, dancing and singing in our unit 'Rhythm in the way we walk'.
