Term 4

English

This term we will be reading *Funny Bones* by Janet and Allan Ahlberg to help us write our own story with a predictable pattern and using what we have learnt in science about the season of Spring to write an acrostic poem.

Art

In Art we will be producing self-portraits and using our hands to create some sensory artwork.

History

In History we will be comparing hospitals in the past to today's hospitals to build our understanding of important changes that have happened and the effects these have had.

Maths

In Maths we will be starting our topic Place Value within 50, then moving on to Measurement where we will be learning about Length and Height, and Weight and Volume.

Hospital Heroes

This term we will explore and find out about a variety of people associated with hospitals and learn about the lives of significant individuals from the past such as Edith Cavell and Florence Nightingale.

PSHE

In PSHE our topic is 'Healthy Me'. We will be learning about how we can be healthy through healthy eating, being physically active and keeping ourselves safe.

PE

Our PE topics this term are Mindfulness and Net and Wall. The children will learn the basic skills needed to play Net and wall games and the importance of the ready position. They will learn about wellbeing through building strength, flexibility and balance.

Design Technology

In DT we will be investigating, designing, and making our own fruit salads and learning about being healthy.

Science

In science we will be learning all about our bodies.

We will be identifying, naming, drawing, and labelling the basic parts of the human body and learning which part of the body are associated with each sense.

Key drivers

Music - In Music we will be building on what we have learnt about Pulse, rhythm and pitch, rapping, dancing and singing in our unit Round and Round.
