PE

Our PE topics this term are
Fundamentals, where the children
will develop skills of balancing,
running, changing direction,
jumping, hopping, and skipping
and Ball Skills where we will learn
about ball control.

Geography

In Geography we will be finding out about the four countries of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.

We will learn about the capital cities and the traditions within each of the four countries.

Design Technology (DT)

In Design Technology we will be finding out about the process of DT to create a product.
We will then use what we learn to design, make, and evaluate a new bridge to help the Three
Billy Goats Gruff cross the river.

English

In English we are going to be developing new skills to help us with our writing.

We will be reading and exploring a variety of traditional tales and stories linked to our topic to help us along our journey, and using our imaginations to create our own interesting stories.

Are We Nearly There Yet?

This term we will journey through the four countries that comprise the United Kingdom and discover key landmarks, traditional tales, music, dance, art, and geographical features...

Maths

In maths we are going to be building a strong foundation for our future maths by working on creating a deep understanding of numbers within 10.

We will focus on Place Value within 10 and Addition and Subtraction within 10.

Science

In science we will be learning about what science is and what it means to be a scientist, while conducting some simple experiments.

We will also be exploring the season of Autumn and different types of weather, drawing on our own experiences.

Art

In art we are going to be learning and exploring our drawing skills.

We will use what we learn to create line drawings of a selection of London Landmarks and then use these to create Mono Prints.

PSHE

In PSHE our topic is
'Being Me in My World'.

We will be learning about how our choices have an impact on others.

Our rights, responsibilities, rewards and consequences and our roles and responsibilities within our school and community.

Key drivers

To learn about the country we live in and it's place in the world.

Music - In Music our unit is called **Hey You!** It is written in an Old-School Hip Hop style for children to learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm, and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

RE - We will be learning about Christianity and answering the question 'Does God want Christians to look after the world?'.
