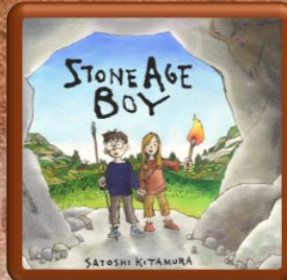
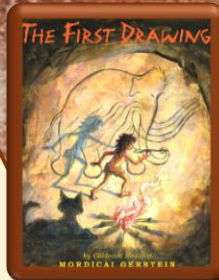


The Stone Age Y3 T1

History:

This term in History, we will explore the Stone Age in Britain, learning about early humans, evidence from the past, ancient settlements, Skara Brae, and important artefacts.



Writing:

In writing, we will write instructions, write a Stone Age diary, create a narrative based on The First Drawing, and learn to write informal letters, alongside weekly spelling practice.

Maths:

In maths, we will develop number skills to 1,000, including place value, counting, comparing, ordering, estimating, addition patterns and number bonds, alongside daily arithmetic and times tables practice.

Art and Design:

The learning will start using a story as a stimulus, finding out the story behind the 'Lion Man', using this to inspire us to create our own 3D sculptures using clay. We will also be creating Stone Age Cave Art!

Guided reading:

In reading, we will develop our VIPERS comprehension skills through Charlotte's Web, Stone Age non-fiction extracts including Stone Houses and Skara Brae, and poetry, while practising weekly spellings.
