

Stone Age to the Iron Age

Year 3 Term 1

History:

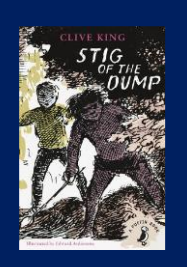
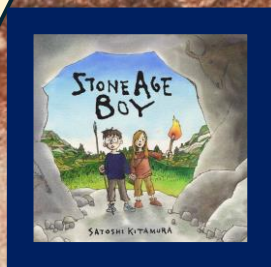
This term, pupils will learn about the Stone Age, exploring prehistory, survival, homes, tools, art, and the transition to farming through hands-on activities and a visit to the archaeological site Flag Fen.

Spelling:

We will be learning to spell words where the digraph 'ou' makes an /ow/ sound, words where the digraph 'oi' makes a /oi/ sound, words where 'y' makes an /i/ sound, words ending in '-sure', words ending in '-ture', alongside challenge words.

English:

We will be reading 'Stone Age Boy' and 'Stig of the Dump' to immerse ourselves in our learning of the Stone Age. We will also use this as base for writing, retelling the story through diary entries of the main characters. We will also look at 'The Secret Song' and create our own class anthology based around this poem.



Maths:

We will be learning place value and number, understanding the value of each digit in any number up to 1000. After this, we will begin addition and subtraction using a range of methods, including column method and looking for links between the numbers.

Art and Design:

The learning will start using a story as a stimulus, finding out the story behind the 'Lion Man', using this to inspire us to create our own 3D sculptures using clay. We will also be creating Stone Age Cave Art!
