Stone Age to the Iron Age Year 3 Term 1

History:

This term, pupil's will learn about the Stone Age, exploring prehistory, survival, homes, tools, art, and the transition to farming through handson activities and a visit to the archaeological site Flag Fen.

Spelling:

We will be learning to spell words where the digraph 'ou' makes an /ow/ sound, words where the digraph 'ou' makes a /w/ sound, words ending in '-sure', words ending in '-ture', alongside challenge
