


Under the Canopy

Year 3 Term 4



Geography:

We'll continue learning about rainforest flora and fauna, the effects of deforestation, and the rainforest's vital role in sustaining our planet.



English:

This term's texts explore rainforest life, friendship, and adventure through fiction, non-fiction, and poetry. Children will write narratives inspired by Journey, persuasive campaigns from The Vanishing Rainforest, and emotional clerihews linked to Charlotte's Web, deepening empathy and creative expression.



Maths:

We'll deepen our understanding of fractions and their real-life applications, then move on to mass and capacity—learning how to measure, compare, and solve practical problems.

Art and Design:

: Inspired by Henri Rousseau, children will add texture to observational drawings, experimenting with techniques to bring rainforest scenes to life.
