

# Ancient Egyptians

## Year 3 Term 5

### History:

Explore Ancient Egypt's geography, daily life, and beliefs. Learn about pharaohs, pyramids, gods, and hieroglyphics. Build historical understanding through engaging lessons focused on culture, society, and the legacy of the Nile.

### English:

This term we will read Flat Stanley and the Great Egyptian Robbery and Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx, and develop our writing skills through riddle poetry, narrative writing focused on discovering the Sphinx, and instructional writing by creating clear instructions on how to wrap a mummy.

### Spelling:

This term we will focus on words with the suffix '-er', words where the digraph 'ch' makes a /k/ sound, words ending in '-gue' and '-que', words where the digraph 'sc' makes a /s/ sound, words that are homophones as well as challenge words.

### Maths:

We'll tackle fractions, money, and time—developing reasoning skills through problem-solving and real-life applications.

### Art and Design:

This term we will explore Ancient Egyptian art and artists to develop our drawing, 3D making and creative skills, finishing with expressive artwork inspired by Keith Haring.
