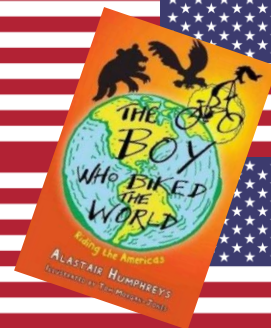


Year group: 4

### English

We begin the term by continuing with our exploration of Ancient Greek myths and legends. We will be creating our own mythical stories with supernatural characters and detailed setting descriptions. Following on from this, we will be looking at persuasive texts using the text, 'The Boy who Biked the World part 2 – The Americas' as inspiration.

### Geography –
