I am your teacher. My name is Mrs Ellis. I will help you learn while you are at school.



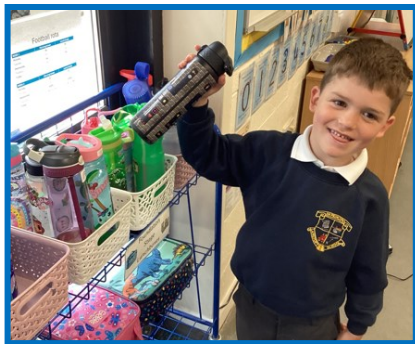
I am your teaching assistant and I also help you to learn.
