REPORTS

End of academic year reports will be sent home on Tuesday 19th July. WATER FIGHT!

As an end of year treat, and to help keep cool in this hot weather, we are organising a water fight in school on Monday 18th July. Classes will have an allocated slot during the day to have lots of fun with their friends. Children may bring in a small water pistol or empty washing up liquid/water bottle to use (no large super soakers or Nerf guns please), a towel and dry clothes to change into afterwards. We suggest that all children come to school in their PE kit and bring spare shorts and T-shirt (in a carrier bag) to change in to after the water fight.

HOT WEATHER

With the temperature looking to increase further over the weekend and beginning of next week, all children can come dressed in PE kit on both Monday and Tuesday. Please ensure that your child has had suncream applied before they come to school. They can also bring suncream with them to reapply during the day but this must be done by themselves, staff will not be able to apply suncream for them. Also, please send your child in with a hat and ensure they have their drinks bottle. We will be ensuring the children drink plenty of cold water during the day and will be utilising the shade outdoors and any cool spaces in school to make the children as comfortable as possible.

YEAR 1

I can't believe we are going into our final week! This week we are planning to have lots of fun! We will be looking back at everything we have learnt this year and reflecting on the amazing journey everyone has had. We will be making posters and creating an 'All about me!' fact file for Mrs Pennell. We are going to be using everything we have learnt in English to write our own stories and playing some maths games on the laptops.

YEAR 2

Next week we have a busy week in Year 2, completing all of our projects. We will be writing and recording our weather reports in English. In maths, we will be completing challenges related to this year's learning.

In mathematics, we will be exploring symmetry in shapes and patterns. We will also be finishing off our topic work and writing journey. YEAR 5

Wow! I cannot believe we have reached our final week of Year 5. This year feels like it has flown by. The class have been wonderful to teach, and we dearly hope their enthusiasm and thirst for knowledge continues.

It may be our final week, but we still have some work to do amongst water fights, the Year 6 dress rehearsal and film afternoons! In maths, we focus on the use of the prefix 'kilo' in units of length and mass, meaning a thousand. We convert from metres to kilometres, grams to kilograms and vice versa.

In history, we shall look at how the Maya number system works and explain what the Mayan writing system consists of, how words are constructed and what codices are,
