ORDERING SCHOOL DINNERS REMINDER

Y3 and Y4 can now order a cooked school dinner for Term 3 (as well as EYFS, Y1 and Y2). The deadline for families to place their orders online using their *The Farm Kitchen* account is **3pm on Tuesday 29 December 2020**.

SCHOOL SHOES AND TRAINERS REMINDER

From the beginning of Term 3 we ask that children come to school wearing school shoes rather than trainers. We ask that they are still provided each day with a pair of trainers in a bag to change in to for the Daily Mile. This pair of trainers can be kept in school all week or brought home with the child if the trainers are needed out of school that day.
